One of the most celebrated architects living today, Frank Gehry has been instrumental in bringing fluidity and dynamic movement to the usually static visual language of architecture. 1983 at the beginning of his career, Gehry was commissioned for the interior build-out of Rebecca's, an upscale Mexican restaurant on North Venice Blvd. in Venice, California. Along with work by his artist friends Ed Moses, Tony Berlant and Peter Alexander, Gehry created an impressive undersea world that included two massive crocodile fixtures that hung from the ceiling.
